Counterbalance Forklift License St Catharines - Forklifts, when operated by fully trained workers, are a major asset to companies. We offer a thorough training program consisting of all aspects of operating a powered lift machinery. Counterbalance forklift training provides forklift operators with the practical skill and understanding needed to operate forklifts safely and efficiently. The program provides a combination of classroom theory, hands-on training and participant observation in a warehouse-type surroundings. Training can be on site and/or customized.

The course goes through the lift truck fundamentals, rules and regulations, parts, load centres and factors affecting stability. Procedures about the general operation of the forklift is taught, in addition to circle checks, startup, forward/reverse on level ground, shutdown, and operating around other individuals. Load handling subject matters consist of selection of loads, load pickup and placements, load security and integrity, loading and off-loading trailers. Participants would learn operational maintenance procedures, like for example refueling and recharging. Workplace safety issues would be discussed. Participants will know the environmental conditions affecting the performance of the lift truck and be able to recognize possible hazards. Advanced training on propane handling could be included.

Employers and their employees might face penalties if they do not operate based on national and industry standards. Workers operating a counterbalance forklift will have to be well-informed about the safe operation guidelines of their forklift. Training is suggested for any individual applying for a job that requires forklift operation.

Inside our personalized small classes, we offer both in-class theory and hands-on training. The choices for personalized training would consist of refresher or entry level courses.

Entry-level Course Outline:

This course is for anyone entering the work force as an operator of a forklift. Students who are successful should finish the program and pass a series of practical and written exams. Topics includes: general operating procedures; basics of powered lift trucks; operational maintenance; load handling; workplace safety; basic rules and regulations.
