Instructor training usually is held at an equipment sales facility or at the campus of a junior college, community college, or technical or vocational school. Forklift manufacturing businesses occasionally offer practical, hands-on, train-the-trainer programs.

Whether offered in a classroom setting or at a manufacturing company facility, registering for the course would involve paying a tuition fee, and buying books, manuals or other materials. Program length varies depending on the program. Participants usually must have satisfactory participation, demonstration, and test scores throughout the course in order to qualify for trainer certification.

It is assumed that the trainee taking the instructor program will have prior experience utilizing forklifts. The topics of ethics, teaching techniques, safety issues and curriculum design will be the main focus throughout the instructor training program. Participants will know how to demonstrate to their students different aspects of forklift operation, like for instance navigating the lift truck in narrow aisles or moving and stacking materials. Individuals participating would learn how to assess student's written exams and demonstrations of their forklift operating skills.
