It is important that all workplaces utilizing forklifts have the checklist below or one equivalent on the premises. If all of the safety rules are being followed, each of these questions must be answered with a "yes". A "no" to whichever question indicates a procedural weakness that could lead to injury, damage to machinery or accident.

- 1) Is the traffic of the pedestrians separate from the operating are of the forklift?
- 2) Is pedestrian access to travel areas of the forklift restricted by barriers?
- 3) The walkways for pedestrians are well-marked?
- 4) Are "forklift in operation" signs clearly visible?
- 5) Are mirrors for drivers and pedestrians provided at blind spots?
- 6) Are changes to daily forklift schedules communicated to all affected staff?
- 7) Are lift truck tires suitable for use on all operating surfaces?
- 8) Is the seatbelt being used?
- 9) The forklift seat is in good condition?
- 10) The maintenance schedule of the forklift is being followed?
- 11) Is a yearly forklift inspection and certification carried out?
- 12) Is the kind of forklift appropriate for the job?
- 13) Is there a load chart that is readable on the forklift?
- 14) Do all operators understand how to read the load chart?
- 15) The chart lists the safe lifting capacity for all attachments and their uses?
- 16) Do the forklift warning devices work properly?
- 17) The speed operating control device is secured correctly?
- 18) Is overhead cage fitted correctly on the forklift?
- 19) Have all lift truck operators obtained certification?
- 20) Speed limits and warning signs are being observed?
- 21) Are lift truck operators up to date on training for all kinds of forklifts being operated?
- 22) Forklift operators understand their responsibilities to report the damage to the machine and other lift truck accidents?
- 23) Is the pre-test checklist reviewed every day prior to the machine being operated?
